Faith and Knowledge

By focusing on enriching the education of children within the parish, the parishioners of St. Louis have demonstrated their faith and enhanced their own spiritual development. The school has been dedicated to providing a safe and nurturing environment while preparing its students for the future through



spiritual, intellectual, physical and moral formation. The school remains committed to providing quality education in the spirit of Christ in accordance with the teaching of the Roman Catholic Church. Children learn at a young age about holding Jesus close to their hearts, living their faith and doing what is right. The school enables parents and families in our parish to pass on our Catholic faith to their children and future generations.

Meeting the Need

The costs of keeping pace with new developments in technology, curriculum and facilities, as well as providing assistance for economically disadvantaged families, cannot be fully absorbed into reasonable tuition fees, parish subsidies and short-term fundraising. An additional source of revenue is necessary to meet and address the rising cost of quality Catholic education delivered by the school and to assist families in the parish who are unable to pay the tuition fees of the school. Accordingly, the Msgr. Paul W. Clunan Endowment Fund was established as an enduring source of additional support for the school.
